

## Horton Kirby & South Darenth Parish Council Freedom of Information Publication Scheme<sup>1</sup>

The Freedom of Information Act came into force in 2005 and encourages greater openness and transparency across the public sector. The Act requires the Council to adopt a scheme of information available to the public as part of its normal business activities. The Information Commissioner's Office, ICO, have produced this model scheme which may be adopted without modification by any public authority without further approval and will be valid until further notice. This document specifies what information the Council will routinely publish, in what format that information will be available and whether the Council will charge for providing the information and if so the level of charge.
