#### 29 MAINTENANCE MATTERS

#### 31 HALL USER FEEDBACK

Feedback forms are given to all casual hirers in the key pack and encouraged by the Clerk to complete them when they have finished using the hall so that any issues can be dealt with promptly. The summary of the 127 forms collected over the past year were shared (attached to minutes).

The overall response was very positive with the 13 minor problems reported being dealt with.

The following suggestions/issues from hall users were reported as follows with the Committees' decision on each noted:

**Bar area in Village Hall could be better/difficult to set up:** ideas gathered from Hall users as to how this could be improved and to inform a project to improve the room. The Piano should be removed as soon as possible.

No teaspoons: buy 20 cheap spoons for each hall and replace as necessary

Longer Office hours: Office hours will remain the same

No drinking water in the Parish Room: advise hirers they should bring bottled water with them.

Hooks in the walls to hang decorations from in Jubilee Hall: add to maintenance list for this to be done

**Rubbish Bins/having to take rubbish home:** no change to this – too expensive to provide service

**Bigger tables in the Jubilee Hall:** move the spare table from the Village Hall to the Jubilee Hall

No Cake knife/scissors: no change; these items are not to be provided

Cutlery and plates: no change; these items are not to be provided
