112 MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

RESOLVED that the Minutes of the last meeting held on 28th October be approved and signed as a correct record.

Willow Tree in Picnic Area: still outstanding.

Shrubbery Road/Playground Inspection: still outstanding

Planning Enforcement re Verge opposite Village Hall: Sevenoaks Planning Enforcement had been contacted but no action to date to remove gate/fencing from the gap in the hedge giving access to Plot 4

114 PLANNING

Due to time constraints with in which to make comments to Sevenoaks District Council, Councillors gave consideration to the following Planning Applications at this meeting:

OBJECTION. Concerns were raised regarding outstanding Enforcement Notices which had not been heeded and the general management of the site which has been well documented in Parish Council meeting minutes.

NO OBJECTION but note previous comments to be reiterated that signage should only be lit during opening hours to avoid nuisance lighting to neighbouring properties.

115 WESTMINSTER FIELD

Pavilion Windows following vandalism to the windows by a catapult or air rifle, means of protection were discussed.

It was agreed to seek quotes for roller shutters and Derek Chambers offered to bring a prototype wooden shutter to the next meeting for further consideration.

CCTV cameras were discussed but the legality of their use in a public place needs to be given further consideration

As the Pavilion is often used by youngsters as a kicking wall (kicking a ball against the wall with a chalk drawn goal) damage to roof tiles and guttering has resulted.

ACTION:

Clerk to obtain quote for roller shutters,
DC to bring prototype to next meeting.
Both to look into CCTV pros/cons.
Look into Goal options for use in Westminster Field to prevent misuse of Pavilion

Footpath SD93/DR93 cuts across the Westminster Field towards the 100 Year Wood and is a well-used route by commuters from Farningham Road Station. The path is narrowing due to encroachment of grass and KCC Footpath manager has asked that this be monitored.

ACTION: Cllr Blackamore to check path and report back to next meeting.

Care Park Hedge: Cllr Blackamore queried whether Richard Abel's quote for hedge cutting (postponed due to ongoing wet weather and water logged ground) included the hedge in the car park. After some discussion it was agreed that if not and it could be completed for under £100 this should be included in the work.

119 TOP PADDOCK

Following previous discussions about fencing the boundary next to the Paddock Close flats it was considered that the situation should be monitored next spring/summer. There is clear evidence of a previous entry point with gate posts in place and a pathway leading from Paddock Close.

122 PLAY AREAS

Cllr Blackamnore reported that Saxon Place Play area is looking very tired from being well used. He recommended that this is considered in next year's budget for an overhaul and possible match funding sought.

123 BURIAL GROUND

The development of a Garden of Remembrance was discussed and how this would be best managed. A wall along the top of the bank with a path in front for displaying memorial plaques and marking the area with either a fence or hedge was the preferred layout.

Setting plaques/stones into the ground to mark interred ashes was considered but the cost of cutting grass around each stone prohibitive and difficult.

ACTION: Cllr Blackamore and Clerk to obtain quotes for the wall and boundary options

125 ALLOTMENTS

Martin Mason reported that the tracks leading to the allotments has worn low causing the grass section in the middle to catch vehicles' undercarriage. The tracks get very muddy and cars have had difficulty accessing the site.
